

Halifax Christian School Student Dress Code

Boys:

Shirts

- Collared shirts (no pictures or writing)
- Solid sweaters or turtlenecks
- *no sweatshirts or pull over hoodies

Pants

- Slacks, Docker-style (no rips, frays, holes, Or blue jeans
- Full length pants or shorts
- Pants/shorts must fit appropriately

Girls:

Shirts

- Collared shirts (no pictures or writing)
- Solid sweaters or turtlenecks
- *no sweatshirts or pull over hoodies

Skirts/Jumpers

- Length must not exceed three inches above the knee

Pants

- Slacks, docker-style (no rips, frays, holes, or blue jeans)
- Full length pants
- Shorts no shorter than 4 inches above knee or 'capri pants
- No leggings as pants, top must meet length of shorts to be used as leggings

Dress-Up Days

Occasionally on Chapel days, Game days, or other announced days students will be asked to 'dress up.' This will include the following

- No Jeans
- Button-down collared shirts for boys (tucked in with belt)
- No tennis shoes
- Blouses (no pictures or writing) with slacks or skirts for girls (dresses are ok also as long as length is no shorter than three inches above knee
- No sleeveless

Boys and Girls Requirements for Uniforms

All school uniforms must be clean and neat without tears, rips, or patches. Tennis shoes are required for PE. Additional requests regarding dress code may be made as needed or for special events/trips at the school's discretion.

- No tight-fitting shirts or pants
- No low-cut blouses or shirts
- Shoes must have non-marking soles
- Sandals are permitted
- No sleeveless shirts or shirts with sheer or cut out areas

Free dress or Dress-down Dollar Days

The following standards apply when students are allowed to have Free Dress or on Thursday Dress (cost \$1 for the school's charitable contributions)

- No tight-fitting shirts or pants
- Christian T-Shirts are permitted
- Thin, transparent, see-through shirts are not permitted
- Sweatshirts or hoodies are permitted.
